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| Read a rhyming book together, and think of as many rhyming words as you can! | Look up jokes for kids, and spend time talking about funny jokes together. | Sit on a towel. Pretend it's a magic carpet. Where will you go? | Sing a favorite song super slow, then super fast! | Pour salt, flour, or sprinkles on a shallow plate. Use your finger to trace different shapes or letters on the plate. |
| Read a nonfiction book about a job that interests your child, then pretend you are doing the job together. | Talk about today's weather. Is it hot or cold, sunny or cloudy? What should you wear to go outside? | Have an inside picnic with your favorite stuffed animals. | Have a dance party! Dance, clap, and sing along to your favorite songs. | Make your own alphabet book! Cut out pictures from magazines and food boxes for each letter. |
| In the car, read signs that you pass out loud to your child. | Try a new food and talk about the shape, color, taste, and texture. | Free Play! | Make music with things you have in the house, like pots, pans, spoons, boxes, and cups. | Use masking tape to make big letters on the floor. Trace each letter by walking on it or pushing a toy car around it. |
| Read a book you've never read before. | Go outside and take an alphabet walk. Talk about things that begin with different letter sounds. | At the grocery store, have a scavenger hunt for things that start with the "b" sound, like bananas, bread, or butter. | In the bathtub, sing as you get clean! "Scrub your head, shoulders, knees and toes, knees and toes!" | Use Q-tips to make a dot painting to help develop the fine motor skills needed for writing! |
| At the grocery, find your favorite flavors by reading labels. For example, "Let's find the chocolate milk!" | Go outside and close your eyes. Talk about the sounds you hear. | Open a pretend bakery! Make donuts, cupcakes, and other treats using play-doh. | Sing "Old MacDonald Had a Farm" and act out each animal. | Use cooked spaghetti to form different shapes and letters. |
