



6th Grade Centurion Summer Reading 2019

You will read two books.

The Reading . . .

Read two books (fiction or nonfiction or one of each) of your choice. They must be at least 150 pages each.

The Photo . . .

For your favorite of the two books, bring to class a print or digital copy of a photograph you have taken that in some way connects to the novel you read. It may be connected to your book in any way (character, setting, theme, main idea, conflict, etc.), but you must be prepared to explain the connection to your classmates. Print copies are acceptable, but digital is preferred and can be emailed to your teacher (see below). Due the 2nd day of school but can be submitted early. You will present your photo to the class sometime during the first two weeks of school to help classmates (and your teacher) who don't know you get to know you better.

The Summary . . .

For your least favorite of the two books, write a paragraph summary of the book. Your summary should be objective (do not inject your opinion into the paragraph) and should sum up the book from beginning to end. The first sentence should include: title, author, genre (type of book), and main idea (nonfiction) or theme (fiction). Your paragraph will be scored on completion and will set a baseline for your skills as a summarizer. *Plagiarism will result in a score of 0 points.*
